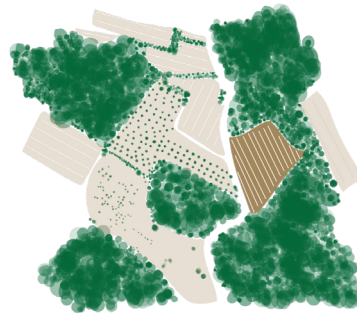

## ORIGIN

Caelus is born in the Can Grau vineyard, located in the municipality of Sant Martí Sarroca at an altitude of 390 m, with a mild climate, influenced by the Mediterranean pre-littoral range.

One of the most interesting Pinot Noir vineyards in the Penedès due to its location, orientation and the care that has been taken since the beginning of its life, designed for the production of Blanc de Noirs.

## PINOT NOIR

To talk about Pinot Noir is to talk about elegance, frankness and subtlety. A variety to which the winery attributes the most appreciated characteristics for the preparation of a Gran Reserva: freshness, complexity and finesse.

## 30 EXPERIMENTAL HARVESTS

Caelus is the culmination of the art of elaboration that allows you to discover and enjoy the maximum expression of Pinot Noir. A variety with which the winery has been experimenting since 1992 with the desire to get as close as possible to excellence.

## ELABORATION

The production of Caelus represents an exciting challenge for the winery: obtaining a white wine from a red grape requires great rigor from the vineyard to the production, but it allows to obtain a unique dimension of aromas and unmistakable.

Manual harvesting and gentle pressing of the whole grapes. Aging with cork for more than 60 months. Manual disgorgement with zero dosage, without the addition of liquor.

## SENSATIONS

**Aromas:** Its complexity and aromatic frankness stand out. Primary aromas of forest fruits and tertiary aromas of toasted bread and toasted hazelnuts.

**Palate:** With a fine and subtle bubble, it surprises with its freshness and liveliness contrasted by the creaminess in the mouth. The freshness persists accompanied by a great immensity of nuances.

**Particularity:** It surprises by how it maintains freshness and vivid aromas, and by the sensory journey that its nuances give it.
