## MALVASIA DE SITGES

A recovered variety

Malvasia de Sitges is the quintessential Mediterranean variety, adapted to the maritime Penedès region for centuries. The arrival of phylloxera and new grape varieties nearly caused its disappearance from the Penedès. In the early 21st century, we were able to recover a few vines preserved in an old vineyard belonging to the Hospital of Sitges.

This recovery has allowed the winery to rediscover the potential of Malvasia de Sitges for producing still white wines with character, freshness, and excellent aging capacity. De Llevant is a fine example: it expresses this uniqueness with a complex aromatic profile and a fascinating evolution over time.

## ELABORATION

15% of the wine is made using the brisat method, where the must ferments in contact with the grape skins, as is done with red wines. This adds structure and complexity to the wine. The remaining portion is aged for 4 months in a egg-shaped ceramic vessel, which provides stability and rounds out the palate while preserving its freshness and aromatic profile.

## SENSATIONS

**Aromas:** Aromatically complex and elegant, with a strong Mediterranean character. Citrus and exotic fruit notes stand out, wrapped in a subtle minerality that adds depth.

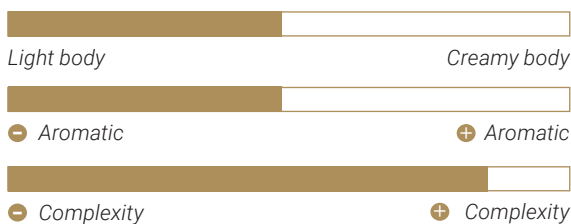
**Palate:** Surprising for its vibrant freshness and well-integrated acidity, which enhances its liveliness. Broad on the palate, with a silky, balanced texture. Long-lasting, with delicate mineral notes and a limestone finish that extends the aftertaste and invites another sip.

**Particularity:** A low-yielding variety that delivers great concentration both on the nose and palate. Harvested at the ideal point of ripeness, it achieves remarkable freshness—resulting in an extremely expressive and refreshing wine.

## PAIRING

Perfect with all Mediterranean-style dishes and raw fish preparations such as sushi, tartare, or tataki. A great choice for warm days and aperitifs.
